You'll be assessed through coursework, tests, assignments, work-based observations and work-based evidence, and as you progress through the course you'll achieve a number of qualifications as part of the Level 3 Apprenticeship Framework:

- Level 3 NVQ Diploma
- Level 3 Diploma
- Essential Skills Qualification Communication
- Essential Skills Digital Literacy
- Essential Skills Qualification Application of Number
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities

On completion, we expect you to be able to carry out your electrical engineering role confidently and competently to the standard set by the Industry.

Entry Requirements

To qualify for this course, you must be employed in the electrical engineering industry, be paid at least the national minimum apprenticeship wage and have a Contract of Employment. As an Apprentice you'll need to attend college on a day release / block release basis, and we'll want you to be fully committed to attending as well as respecting others, having an enthusiasm for the subject and being self-motivated. Your employer must also pass the necessary Health and Safety vetting.
