Course content

Apprenticeships involve a mix of learning in the workplace and college training, giving you the

opportunity to practice and embed new skills in a real work environment.

You'll be assessed through coursework, tests, assignments, work-based observations and work-based evidence, and as you progress through the course you'll achieve a number of qualifications as part of the Level 3 Apprenticeship:

- Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Paint
- Level 3 City & Guilds Diploma in Paint
- Essential Skills qualification Communication
- Essential Skills Qualification Application of Number
- Essential Skills Qualification Digital Literacy
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities

On completion, we expect you to be able to carry out your accident repair role confidently and competently to the standard set by the Industry.

Entry Requirements

To qualify for this course, you'll need to have done the Foundation Apprenticeship and Level 2 Diploma, and must be employed in the automotive industry, be paid at least the national minimum apprenticeship wage and have a Contract of Employment. As an Apprentice you'll need to attend college on a day release / block release basis, and we'll want you to be fully committed to attending as well as respecting others, having an enthusiasm for the subject and being self-motivated. Your employer must also pass the necessary Health and Safety vetting.
