COURSE INFORMATION LEAFLET

To enrol, you'll need a minimum of 4 GCSEs grade D or above (to include either Maths/Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language) or an appropriate Level 1 Diploma qualification in the relevant vocational area, to include either GCSE Maths/Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language grade.

You'll need to be self-motivated, hardworking, take pride in your appearance, be numerate and have a friendly personality. There will be an expectation that you attend work placements in your programme.

All classes take place on campus, and there may be one evening per week when you'll be required to attend college until 7.30pm.

What comes next?

NVQ Level 3 Diploma in Beauty Therapy or Complementary Therapies.

It is highly recommended that you complete the two year programme (Level 2 and Level 3 Beauty Therapy) to equip you with the qualifications required to be employed as a fully qualified Beauty Therapist.
