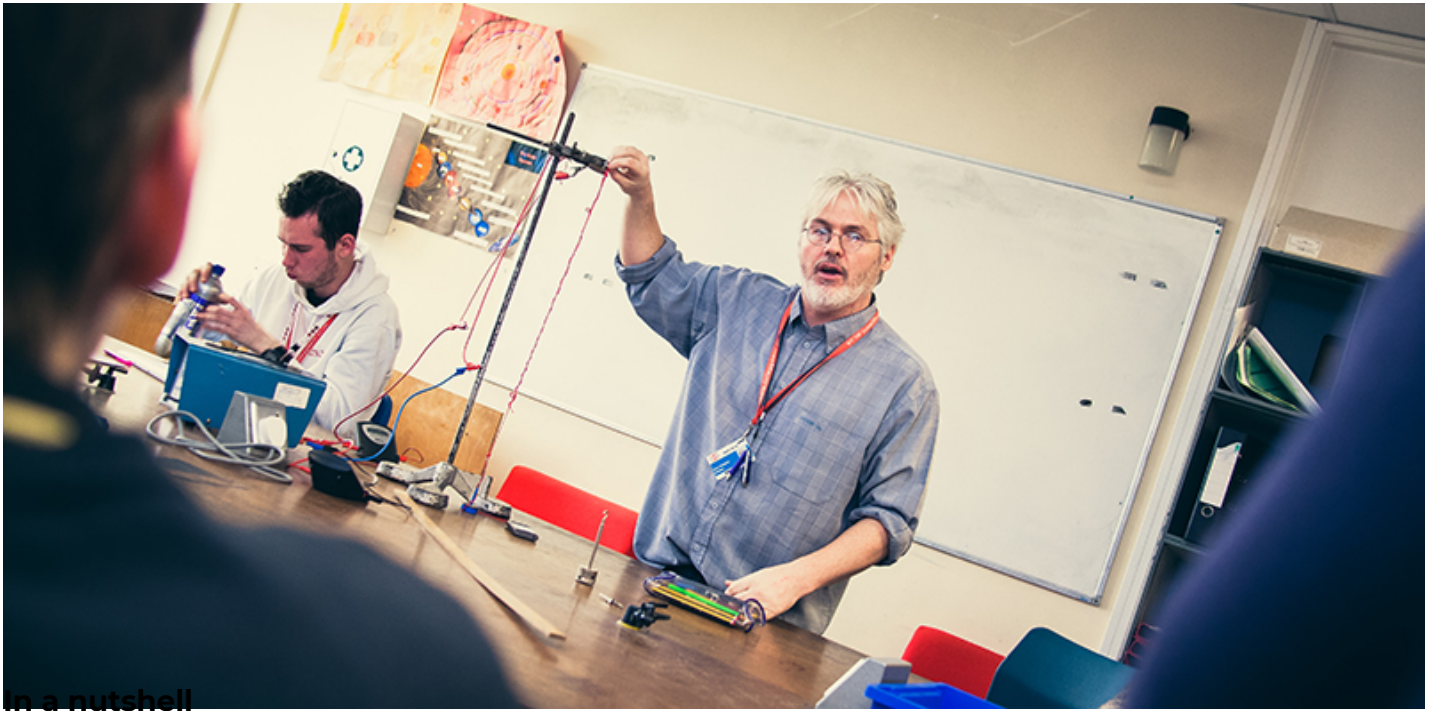


## Agored Cymru Certificate Skills for Further Study Level 2

## What is expected of me?

No academic entry qualifications are required, but you will need to pass a college test. You'll also need a determination to do well, be keen to improve your numeracy and literacy skills and committed to full attendance.

## Additional information

To progress on to an undergraduate degree at most British universities, you'll need to have achieved a minimum Grade C in Maths and English (and Science if you want to train as a primary school teacher). If you want to study Science-based subjects, or Midwifery, you'll also normally need a B in Science.
