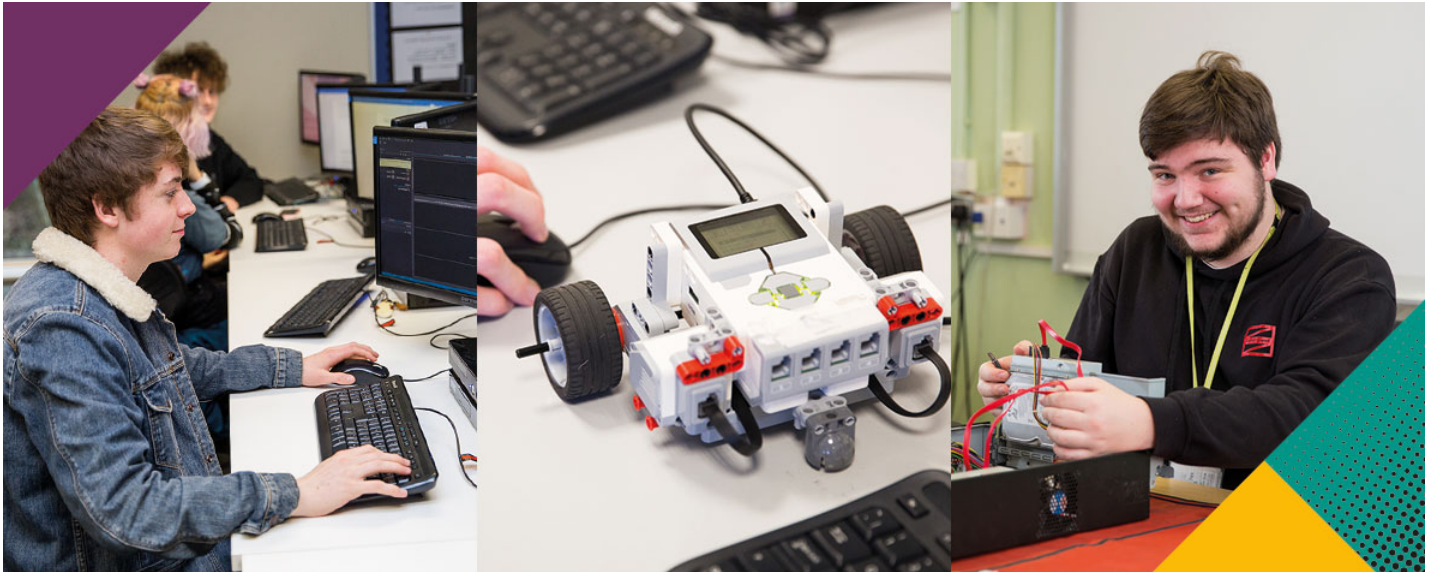


## E-Learning MCSA SQL Server 2012 - Administering SQL Server 2012 Databases (70-462)
