AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting (Level 3) focuses on giving you the skills and knowledge to be able to work in senior accounting roles.

AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting (Level 4) focusses on what you have learnt throughout levels 2 and 3, while teaching you how to evaluate financial performance and manage budgets.

Course content

The six modules that you'll cover in the AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting (Level 3), are:

- Advanced Bookkeeping
- Final Accounts Preparation
- Indirect Tax
- Management Accounting: Costing
- Ethics for Accountants
- Spreadsheets for Accounting

The AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting (Level 4) is made up of 4 mandatory modules and a choice of 5 options modules (of which you must complete 2).

Mandatory Modules include:

- Management Accounting: Budgeting
- Management Accounting: Decision and Control
- Financial Statements of Limited Companies
- Accounting Systems and Controls
- Professional Diploma Synoptic Assessment

Optional modules include:

- Business tax
- Personal tax
- External auditing
- Cash and Treasury Management
- Credit Management
