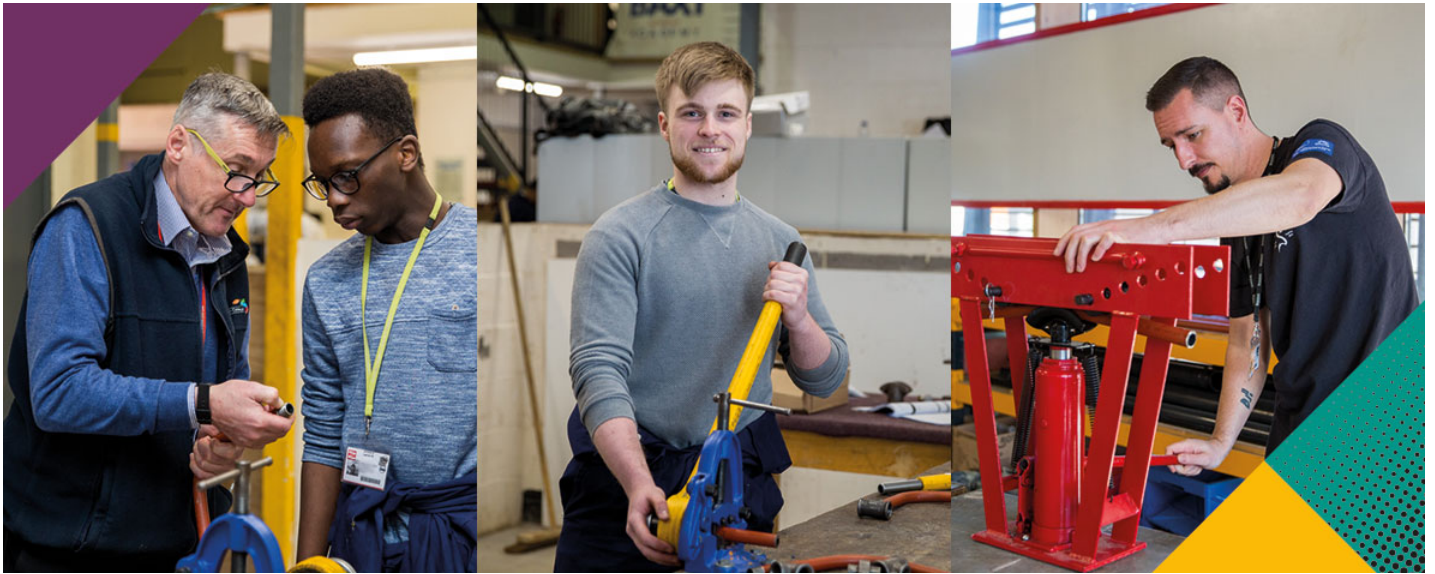


City & Guilds Diploma in Plumbing Studies Level 2
