COURSE INFORMATION LEAFLET

What is expected of me?

To enter the course, you'll need the Level 1 Diploma in Hairdressing and either GCSE Maths/Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language grade D or above.

You'll need to be self-motivated, hardworking, numerate and have a friendly personality. There'll be an expectation that you attend work placement in your programme. All delivery takes place on campus and there will be one evening a week when you may be in college until late. Attendance and punctuality for all sessions is a major requirement of this course.

What comes next?

Level 3 in Hairdressing or employment at a senior apprentice level.

Additional information

You'll be expected to purchase a uniform and hairdressing kit as a condition of your place on the course. The cost of this is approximately £100- £160. Bringing in clients for assessments is an important part of the course, therefore a salon fee of £90 is applied which covers all practical services and assessments on family and friends in salons.

All costs are under review and subject to change.
