What is expected of me?

To enter the course, you'll need the Diploma Level 1 in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair at Merit Grade. Direct entry with a minimum of 5 GCSE's grade C or above to include Maths/Numeracy, English and a Science.

Full commitment to attendance is required, as the ability to work independently and as part of a team. You should have a strong desire to work in the motor vehicle industry, abide by the college ethos and be willing to participate in improving their level of academic subjects.
