What is expected of me?

To enter the course, you'll need a Level 1 Diploma in Electrical Installation and, either GCSE Maths/Maths Numeracy, or English/Welsh First Language Grade C or above.

You'll be continually assessed and there's an expectation that you'll continue your studies and coursework during your own time.
