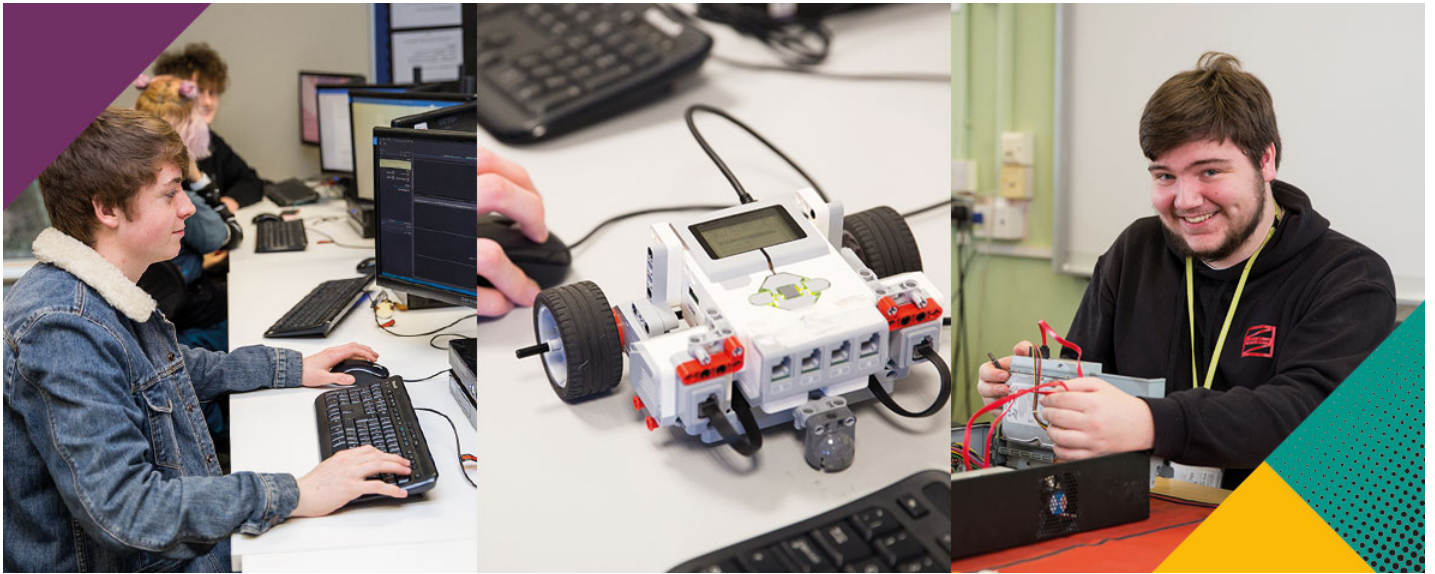


Cyber Security Fundamentals
