

## HND Complementary Healthcare (with Practitioner status)



### In a nutshell

This two-year course is an excellent opportunity to extend your learning and experience within the field of healthcare, enabling you to achieve Complementary Healthcare with Practitioner status.

There is a combination of theory and practical work on this course, with a strong emphasis on clinical work-based learning opportunities underpinning the programme.

On completion of the course, your HND is equivalent to the first two years of an undergraduate degree, so you should be eligible for direct entry to the final year of a three-year undergraduate degree in a related field.

The course will require you to read around the subject and be aware of current research in the field as you progress through your two-year programme.

### **What comes next?**

Following completion of your HND course, you can further progress and complete an undergraduate degree in the field of complementary therapies.

Your HND is equivalent to the first two years of an undergraduate degree so you should be eligible for direct entry to the final year of a three-year undergraduate degree in a related field. Different universities will have different entry requirements in terms of the grade they require in your HND, so please check anticipated University entry requirements.

Alternatively, if you wish to go straight into work with your HND, you'll find that you can apply for more senior or more specialist roles within the sector.

### **Additional information**

This programme is currently subject to approval by Cardiff Metropolitan University.

You'll be required to wear a clinical uniform and appropriate footwear that can be purchased through the college. The cost of this will be a maximum of £100.

You'll also be required to apply and pay for a DBS check and this can also be arranged through the college.
