Practitioner-based module of:

The BCS Practitioner Certificate in Modelling Business Processes

What will I be doing?

The three core modules are:

The BCS Practitioner Certificate in Business Analysis Practice – Providing a holistic view of the organisation through strategic analysis techniques and tools, and

The BCS Practitioner Certificate in Requirements Engineering – Fully understand the requirements engineering process of eliciting, analysing, validating, documenting, and managing requirements

The BCS Practitioner Certificate in Modelling Business Processes – Taking you through the different levels and aspects of modelling the processes of the business, through to the framework to improve the business processes

What is expected of me?

You will need a Knowledge-based specialism of either:

The BCS Foundation Certificate in Business Analysis – An overview of the principles, techniques, and tools of the Business Analyst, or

The BCS Foundation Certificate in Commercial Awareness – The understanding of the financial, cultural, and organisational behaviour that effects all businesses
