Understanding effective working teams – to develop skills in making sure teams work effectively.

Planning and monitoring work – to develop understanding and ability to plan and monitor the work of the team effectively and efficiently.

Learners will also have trainer-led workshops for each unit and will produce a written assignment.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this course.

Additional information

Once learners have successfully completed the assessments they'll be awarded an Institute of Leadership & Management (ILM) Level 2 Award in Leadership & Team Skills.

They can progress to the ILM Level 2 Certificate in Leadership & Team Skills by adding further units to the ones already achieved, or may want to undertake the ILM Level 2 (NVQ) Diploma in Team Leading or progress to the ILM Level 3 Award in Leadership & Management.
