The qualification covers the fundamental knowledge and understanding of the All Wales Induction Framework (AWIF) for Health and Social Care, and reflects a range of different roles and settings.

The content covers:

- Health and well-being
- Professional practice as a health and social care worker
- Safeguarding individuals
- Health and safety in health and social care, as well as a further four units that cover the Principles and Contexts of Health and Social Care.

You'll learn through group work, classroom-based learning and a work experience, which is a compulsory part of the programme.

You'll be assessed through case scenarios, multiple choice and examinations and you'll achieve:

Level 2 Health and Social Care - Adult Core and Principles and Context.
