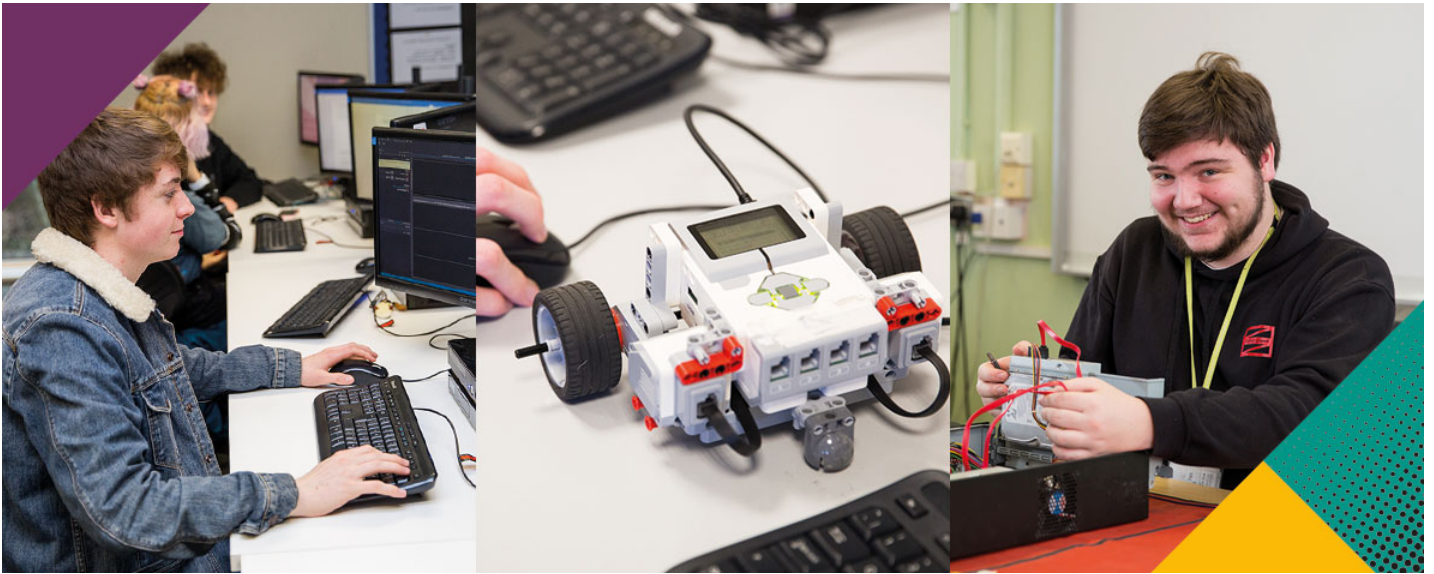


Virtual Classroom - ITIL® 4 Foundation with Exam
