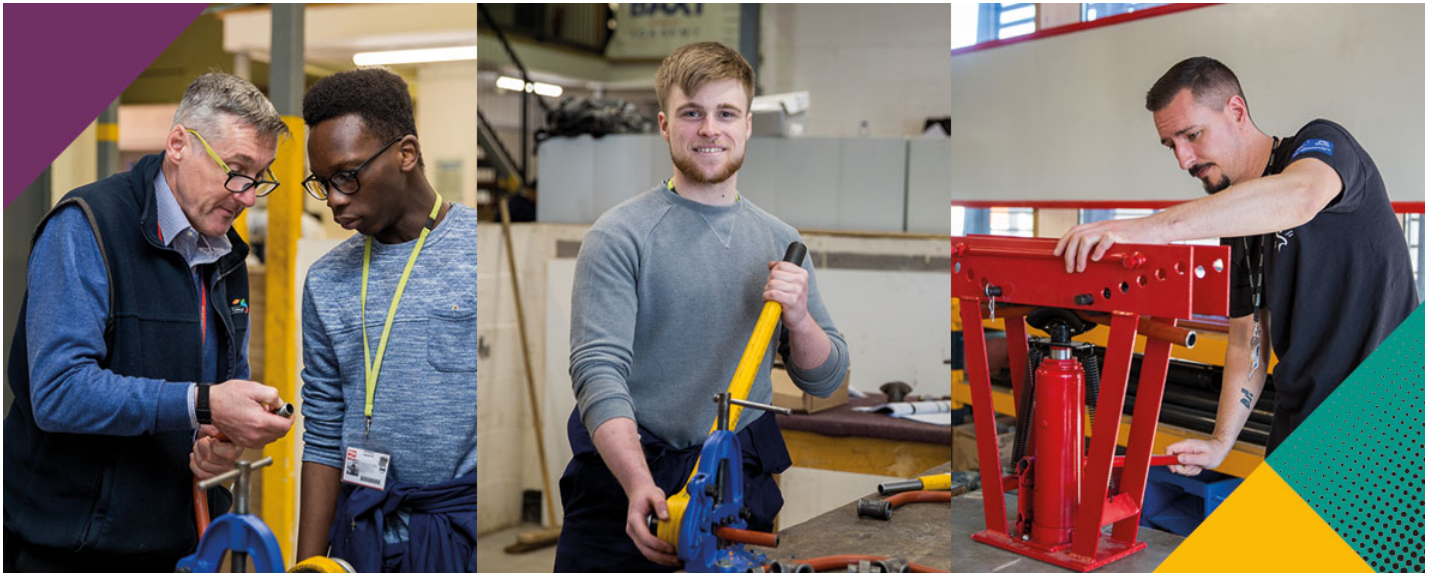


City & Guilds Progression in Plumbing and Heating Level 2
