What is expected of me?

For entry to this course, you'll need Level 1 Diploma in Hairdressing. Learners without GCSE Maths and English will continue to work towards these qualifications.

What comes next?

Level 3 in Hairdressing or employment at a senior apprentice level.

Additional information

You'll be expected to purchase a hairdressing kit as a condition of your place on the course. The cost of this is approximately £70 - £96.

To reflect industry expectations, you will be required to wear a Coleg Gwent salon uniform. The college will fund the cost of one full uniform per year. Additional sets can be purchased for around £45 (TBC); college staff will be able to direct you to the approved supplier if / when needed.

All costs are under review and subject to change.
