What is expected of me?

To enter the course, you'll need the Level 1 Diploma in Hairdressing and either GCSE Maths/Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language grade D or above.

You'll need to be self-motivated, hardworking, numerate and have a friendly personality.

There'll be an expectation that you attend work placement in your programme. All delivery takes place on campus and there will be one evening a week when you may be in college until late. Attendance and punctuality for all sessions is a major requirement of this course.

What comes next?

Upon completion, you can progress onto Level 3 Hairdressing or employment.

Additional information

You'll be expected to purchase a hairdressing kit as a condition of your place on the course. The cost of this is approximately £70- £96.

To reflect industry expectations, you will be required to wear a Coleg Gwent salon uniform. The college will fund the cost of one full uniform per year. Additional sets can be purchased for around £45 (TBC); college staff will be able to direct you to the approved supplier if / when needed.
