In a nutshell

This course is not only the perfect next step in your hairdressing career but also gives you a range of creative hairdressing skills to help you go further.

This course is for you if...

...hairdressers wanting to further their creative hairdressing skills and become a senior stylist.

What will I be doing?

This is a 34 week course. The City and Guilds Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing covers a number of mandatory and optional topics, with assessments carried out at our onsite salon and online multiple choice tests.

Mandatory topics are:

- Providing hairdressing consultation services

- Promoting additional services or products to customers
- Creatively cutting hair using a combination of techniques
- Monitoring procedures to safely control work operations

Optional topics can include:

- Colouring hair using a variety of techniques
- Hair and scalp treatments
- Colour correction services
- Creative hair extension services
- Creatively styling and dressing hair
- Specialist consultation services for hair and scalp conditions
- Creatively dressing long hair
- Developing and enhancing creative hairdressing skills
- Contributing to the financial effectiveness of the business
- Creating a variety of permed effects
- Contributing to the planning and implementation of promotional activities

Supporting customer service improvement

Once you've completed this course, you could progress on to Level 4 in Salon Management, or related courses such as Beauty Therapy or Theatrical and Media Make Up.
