What will I be doing?

The Level 2 Site Carpentry Diploma allows you to learn, develop and practise the skills required for employment and/or career progression in site carpentry.

What is expected of me?

To enrol on the course, you'll need a Level 2 (Foundation) Diploma in Carpentry and Joinery and, either GCSE Maths/Maths Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language Grade C or above.

You need to have a desire to work in the construction industry. Full commitment to attendance is required, as is respect for others, enthusiasm for the subject and self-motivation. You'll be continually assessed and there is an expectation that you'll continue your studies and coursework during your own time.
