

### City & Guilds Foundation in Carpentry and Joinery Level 2



#### In a nutshell

You'll be introduced to carpentry and joinery skills as well as painting and decorating skills. To learn, develop and practise the skills required for employment and/or career progression in carpentry or joinery.

#### This course is for you if...

- ... You'd like a career in carpentry/painting and decorating
- ... You have a keen interest in construction trades
- ... You enjoy practical work and appreciate theoretical study.

#### What will I be doing?

The course covers trade specific studies, such as wood joining techniques (joinery) and basic site carpentry plus basic painting and decorating skills:

### What is expected of me?

To enter the course, you need a minimum of 4 GCSEs, Grade E or above, to include Maths/Maths Numeracy and English/Welsh First Language or an appropriate Entry Level qualification.

You'll need to have a desire to work in the construction industry. Full commitment to attendance is required, as is respect for others, enthusiasm for the subject and self-motivation. You'll be continually assessed and there is an expectation that you'll continue your studies and coursework during your own time.
