Our Vocational Studies courses are designed to introduce you to the area of study that interests you and help you develop wider learning skills.

You'll get the opportunity to try more than one vocational area and gain an insight into college life. You'll develop practical, transferable skills and complete tasks that focus on demonstrating what you can do and what you have learned.

The core units are the same across all our Vocational Studies courses, which will help you develop your skills within your chosen vocational area. If you need to change to a different course, you can transfer the units studied on this course to your next one, if needed.

The core units you'll follow include units such as:

- Being organised
- Developing a progression plan
- Working with others
- Researching a topic

You would then complete units from Public Services and Sport, possibly including:

- Contributing to your community
- Planning and navigating a route
- Responding to an incident
- Taking part in fitness testing
- Playing sport
- Assisting in a sports activity
- Getting people active
- Keeping active and healthy

You'll be assessed through assignments, tasks and practical assessments and, upon completion, you'll receive:
