### **What is expected of me?**

To enter this course, you'll need a minimum of 4 GCSEs, Grade D or above, to include an Art or creative-based subject and either Maths/Maths Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language, or an appropriate Level 1 Diploma qualification in the relevant vocational area, to include either GCSE Maths/Maths Numeracy or English/Welsh 1st Language.

Full commitment to attendance is required, as well as respect for others, enthusiasm for the subject, self-motivation, creative ability and a desire to succeed.
