City & Guilds Diploma in Accident Repair (Paint Principles) Level 2



In a nutshell

This course will enhance your technical and academic knowledge of vehicle technology.

This course is for you if...

- ...You have completed the Level 1 or Entry Level 3 paint principles
- ...You have experience in the vehicle refinishing industry
- ...You want to expand your skills and knowledge

What will I be doing?

The course follows on from the first-year full time body and refinishing course and looks at refinishing in more detail. You'll cover the application of 2K paints, water based and different foundation materials and also look at various application techniques, such as spot repairs, fade



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outs and blow-ins.

You'll cover units in:

Knowledge of health and safety
Knowledge of support for job roles
Knowledge of tools and equipment used in vehicle refinishing
Knowledge of applying fillers and foundation
Knowledge of working with plastics
Knowledge of preparing metal and pre painted surfaces
Knowledge of repairing minor paint surface defects

The course is delivered through a blend of the following:

You'll be assessed via practical and online assessments, oral and written questions. Upon completion, you'll achieve:
