As well as the certificate in Gym instructing, you will also achieve YMCA level 2 Award in Engaging Children and Young People in Sport and Physical Activity and YMCA Level 2 Certificate in Group Exercise Instructing: Circuit Training.

To achieve your YMCA Level 2 Diploma in Gym Instructing You must complete the following units. This qualification is endorsed by the Chartered Institute for the management of sport and physical activity (CIMSPA). You will learn about:

- Anatomy and physiology for exercise and fitness instructors
- Providing a positive customer experience in the exercise environment
- Lifestyle management and health awareness
- Understanding employment within the health and fitness sector
- Developing self
- Mental health awareness and support
- Working with inactive people
- Working in the community to promote and deliver physical activity programmes
- Principles of engaging children and young people in sport and physical activity
- A basic understanding of safeguarding and protecting children and young people
- Planning sport and physical activity for children and young people
- Delivering sport and physical activity for children and young people
- Gym-based programme planning and preparation
- Gym-based programme delivery and professional instruction
- Principles of planning and delivering group exercise
- Plan and deliver group circuit training

Entry Requirements

Minimum of 4 GCSEs Grade D or above to include either Maths or English/Welsh First Language or an appropriate Level 1 Diploma qualification. However, these requirements can be looked at on an individual basis.
