Support for job roles in the automotive environment

Materials, fabrication, tools and measuring devices used in the automotive environment

Diagnosis and rectification of motorcycle electrical faults

Motorcycle preparation and inspection

Diagnosis and rectification of motorcycle engine faults

Diagnosis and rectification of motorcycle chassis system faults

Diagnosis and rectification of motorcycle transmission and driveline faults

Knowledge of how to identify and agree motor vehicle customer service needs

You will also develop essential employability skills, such as self-management, team working, business

and customer awareness, problem solving, communication, basic literacy and numeracy and a

positive attitude to work. You will be assessed through exams, coursework, assignments, portfolio work and practical assessments.
