This course is not only the perfect next step in your hairdressing career but also gives you a range of creative hairdressing skills to help you go further.

This course is for you if...

What will I be doing?

This is a 34 week course. The City and Guilds Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing covers a number of mandatory and optional topics, with assessments carried out at our onsite salon and online multiple choice tests.

Mandatory topics are:

Providing hairdressing consultation services

Promoting additional services or products to customers
Creatively cutting hair using a combination of techniques
Monitoring procedures to safely control work operations

Optional topics can include:

Colouring hair using a variety of techniques
Hair and scalp treatments
Colour correction services
Creative hair extension services
Creatively styling and dressing hair
Specialist consultation services for hair and scalp conditions
Creatively dressing long hair
Developing and enhancing creative hairdressing skills
Contributing to the financial effectiveness of the business
Creating a variety of permed effects
Contributing to the planning and implementation of promotional activities
Supporting customer service improvement

Once you've completed this course, you could progress on to Level 4 in Salon Management, or related courses such as Beauty Therapy or Theatrical and Media Make Up.

As a condition of your place on this course, you will be expected to purchase the appropriate kit, from our approved supplier, costing approximately £140 subject to review/inflationary price increase.
