Background

Following the disruption caused by the Covid-19 outbreak, an announcement on 20 April 2020 by Qualifications Wales confirmed that learners due to complete their qualifications before 31 July 2020 will receive a calculated result.

Will the calculated result apply to all learners?

Learners who have passed either the controlled task (and this has been externally quality assured) or confirmatory test before 20 March 2020 will be awarded the qualification.

Learners who have not successfully completed either the controlled task or confirmatory test prior to 20 March 2020 will receive a calculated result.

How will the calculated result be decided?

This will be based on your performance over the course. Your teacher will award a realistic judgement of the likely outcome you would have achieved, had you taken the assessment this summer. This will be based on all of the evidence that your teacher has on your performance since the start of the course.

Will I be able to re-sit my assessments?

For Application of Number Skills and Essential Communication Skills: you'll be able to take the confirmatory test when the college re-opens. You will not be required to complete the controlled task. This opportunity will be available until 30 November 2020.
