

INDEPENDENT LIVING SKILLS

Independent Living Skills (ILS) are designed for students who aren't ready for mainstream education.

Programmes are tailored to meet the needs of individual learners, accommodating their abilities and aspirations. You'll develop the skills focusing on health and wellbeing, employability, independent living and community inclusion.

Many of our ILS learners go on to study a vocational course after completing the programme.

There are two pathways to choose from:

Employability Courses

You'll learn the skills needed for employment including communication, teamwork and sector specific knowledge. By taking part in work experience, you'll explore different careers until you find the right one for you, receiving coaching on the job.

Living Skills Courses

Focusing on improving self-confidence and independence, you'll work to a bespoke timetable that's suited to your exact needs. You'll learn soft skills that are required by employers, e.g. responsibility, teamworking and self-motivation.

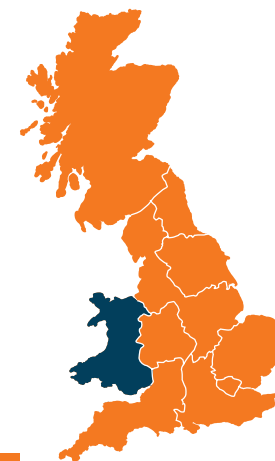
