- In 2020 there were 169,449 Human Resource Managers and Directors jobs in the UK with an average annual salary of £50,200.

- Network 75 offer the highest number of courses to those who want to study business.
- In 2020 there were 432,907 jobs in Marketing which includes Marketing Directors and Market Researchers. The average annual salary is £53,000.
- There were 3.49 million people employed in administrative roles in 2020. This includes, secretaries, receptionists, office managers, assistants, with an average salary of £25,100.
- There were 40,732 actuaries, economists and statisticians employed in the UK in 2020 with an average salary of £51,700.
- The UK's largest recruiter of economists is the Government Economic Service(GES). The GES is the professional body for UK economists in the public sector and employs over 1,500 economists working across more than 30 government departments and agencies.
