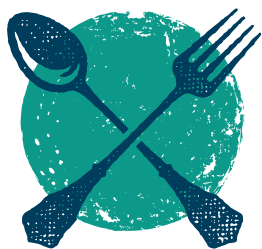

Our rural centre in Usk is home to our landbased, sport, leisure and public services courses.

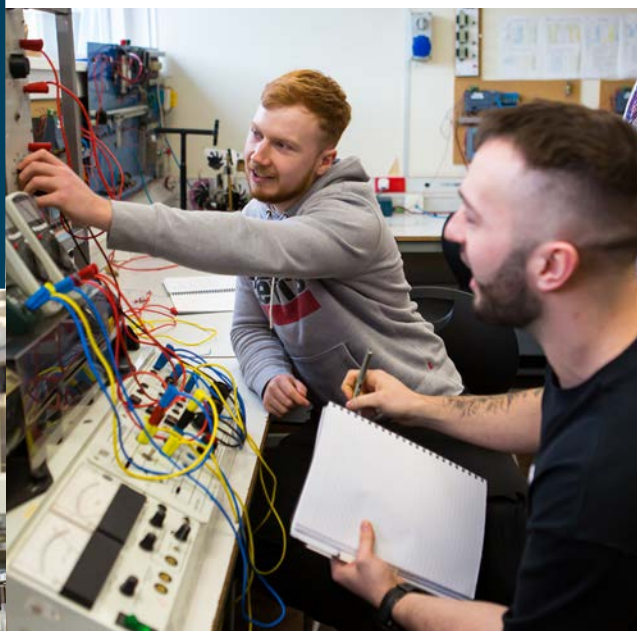

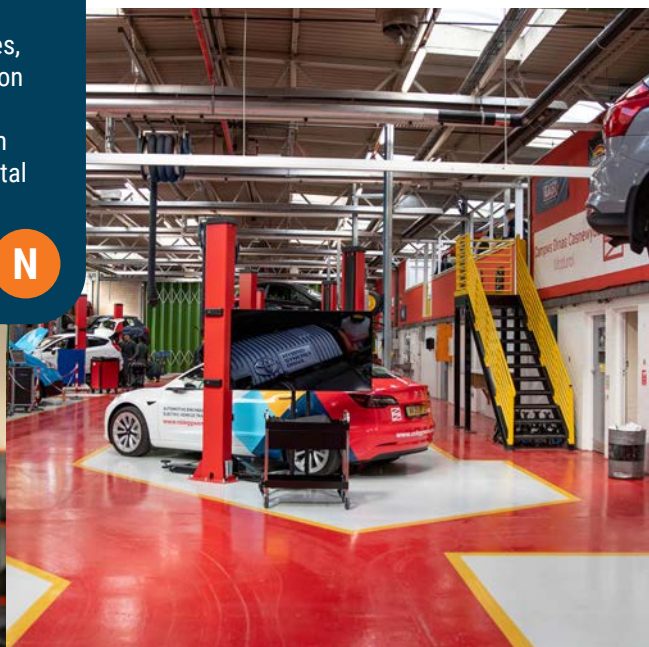
