How we've been Enabling & Accelerating Student Entrepreneurship:

- Delivered tailored class-based workshops to over 500 learners across 5 campuses.
- Enabling 2,443 learners to directly engage with inspiring Big Ideas Wales role models.
- Providing 31 learners with 1:1 enterprise support to create and develop their business idea.
- Engaging 80+ learners in an inspiring Welsh Bacc Advanced Skills 2-day carousel event, to support the Future Destinations (task 2) project.
- Engaged with over 40 tutors who had previously not benefited from Enterprise support, to deliver workshops for their learners.
- Supported 3 learners to successfully achieve the Tafflab award, providing them with a year of grant funding & business advisory support.
