- Delivered enterprise workshops and business start-up clubs across all campuses, supporting learners to develop practical business planning and self-employment skills.
- Engaged more than 1,600 learners through enterprise events, including Global Entrepreneurship Week, Freshers' Fairs and cross-campus Progression Fayres.
- Enabled 200 A-level students at Torfaen Learning Zone to complete the Future Destinations Task 2 project, supported by an expanded team of Big Ideas Wales role models.
- Provided 1:1 and small-group business mentoring to over 30 learners, resulting in new ventures launched, with several securing funding support.
